I Wish You a Merry Christmas How Do We Describe Christmas? We say, "MERRY Christmas".

What Does "Merry" Mean?
It is a word of comfort, meaning "gladness, joyfulness and cheerfulness (these are Bible synonyms), used interchangeably with merry.

What is So "Merry" About Christmas? It features the most unique birth, ever...the birth of Jesus. His birth was a one-of-a-kind virgin birth. The only one in the history of the world. God said this would happen hundreds of years before it occurred, "Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a Son..." 1 It has been His plan.

The First Christmas was a MERRY Christmas. How Can My Christmas Be "Merry"?

First, How can a virgin have a baby? This young woman, Mary, was a virgin before she was pregnant, while she was pregnant, and she was still a virgin on the day the Baby was born. She had never had sexual intimacy with any man...never. She went on record when told that she was the one, chosen of God, to have the

Christ child, "Thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a Son, and shalt call His name JÉSUS."2 Mary replied. "How shall this be, seeing I know not a man?"3 God said that He would directly cause her pregnancy. "Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise...she was found with child of the Holy [Spirit]"4 and "That which is conceived in her is of the Holy [Spirit]. She shall bring forth a Son, and call His name, JESUS..."5 Mary was told directly, that "The Holy [Spirit] shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God. 6 "Mary said, Behold the handmaid of the Lord, be it unto me according to thy word."7 So, for the first time, and the only time ever, a virgin was pregnant -- and with the Son of God, Jesus Christ.

Second, Why did God the Father want a Son? God the Father needed for God the Son to be born into the human family, so that the human race could have a spiritual option. Sin has separated us from our Holy God. We need the Son to get back to God.

The birth of Jesus was God becoming flesh. At the end of Jesus' earthly life, He died on a Cross, not for His sins--He had none, but for our sins. Jesus' death was a payment, that we could not pay. ("The wages of sin is death".)8 But we, as sinners, could not make a righteous payment. Only our righteous God, taking flesh (so He could die), could purchase our salvation. "For she (Mary) shall bring forth a Son, and thou shalt call His name JESUS: for He shall save His people from their sins."9

Finally, How does all this make my Christmas Merry? A MERRY Christmas occurs when you receive the Gift of God, in the person of Jesus Christ, as your personal Savior. Believe, ask and you shall receive.

"For God so loved the world, that He **gave** His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him, should not perish, but have everlasting life." 10 Merry Christmas

YOU HAVE NO RIGHTEOUSNESS IN AND OF YOURSELF: Romans 3:10, 23, "There is none righteous, no, not one: For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."

YOU NEED TO KNOW WHERE TO GET RIGHTEOUSNESS: Romans 5:12, 18, "As by one man [Adam] sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned: As by the offence of one [Adam] judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of One [Christ] the free gift came upon all men [who believel unto justification of life."

YOU MUST BELIEVE THAT YOU NEED HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS: Romans 5:6, 8, "For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners. Christ died for us."

YOU MUST KNOW WHY YOU NEED HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS: Romans 6:23, "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." John 3:16a, "For God so loved the world [mankind], that He gave His only begotten Son [Jesus Christ],

You Must Personally Accept His Righteousness: John 3:16b, "That whosoever believeth in [asks, accepts] Him should not perish [be separated from God forever], but have everlasting life [be with God forever].

JUST ASK HIM FOR HIS SAVING RIGHTEOUSNESS: Romans 10: 9, 10, 13, "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." CONCLUSION: John 5:24
