
## THE CHOICE IS ...


Life is the Sum Total of Choices.



TODAY is the day that you could choose to make your greatest choice...ever. God gave us the gift of choice. We are not robots, controlled by others. We are free to make our choices.



Here is what God's "Menu" (the Bible) offers you TODAY. "Today, if ye will hear His voice, harden not your hearts," Here is what God




## "Take It or Leave It"

YOU HAVE NO RIGHTEOUSNESS IN AND OF YOURSELF: Romans 3:10, 23, "There is none righteous, no, not one: For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." (Also see, Isaiah 64:6)

**YOU NEED TO KNOW WHERE TO GET RIGHTEOUSNESS:**Romans 5:12, 18, "As by one man [Adam] sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned: As by the offence of one [Adam] judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of One [Christ] the free gift came upon all men [who believe]

unto justification of life."

You Must Believe that You Need His Righteousness: Romans 5:6, 8, "For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

You Must Know Why You Need His Righteousness: Romans 6:23, "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." John 3:16a, "For God so loved the world [mankind], that He gave His only begotten Son [Jesus Christ],

You Must Personally Accept His Righteousness: John 3:16b, "That whosoever believeth in [asks, accepts] Him should not perish [be separated from God forever], but have everlasting life [be with God forever].

**JUST ASK THE LORD FOR HIS SAVING RIGHTEOUSNESS:**Romans 10: 9, 10, 13, "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."
