



A Going-to-Heaven "Check-List"

Got a pencil? Rease Get one.
This check-list is based on two questions:
#1 If you were to die, would you go to Heaven?
I think I would go to Heaven.
☐ I hope I would go to Heaven.
I know I would go to Heaven.
☐I'm sure I want to go to Heaven.
☐I'm not sure I would go to Heaven.
I don't know if I would go to Heaven.
You may have checked several answers. That's why there is a second question.
The second question is a little longer, and you should only check ONE answer (Read them all <u>before</u> you make your one selection.)

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#2 If you stood before God at the entrance of Heaven and God asked you, "Why should I let you into My Heaven?" (and you could only give ONE answer) what would you say?

Remember to read all of the following list before making one, and only one , selection
☐I've tried to do my best and to do what is right.
☐I've been baptized.
☐I've been a church member.
☐I've treated others fairly.
☐I've kept at least most of the ten commandments.
☐I've trusted Jesus as my Savior and (plus some of the areas on this list).
☐I've done more good things than bad.
I've given money to charitable and needy causes I've trusted Christ, who paid for m salvation in full.
☐I've kept the golden rule – treating others equal to, or better than, myself.
☐I've taught a Sunday School class.
☐I've been a person of prayer.
☐I've asked God to save me several times.
☐I've done



Did you check one?

There is only one right answer. Basically speaking (and God wrote the Book on it!), salvation is of the Lord.



The answers to the second question can be grouped into two categories: (1) **What Man Did**, and (2) **What God Did**. Only one answer would be under group (2) **What God Did**, and that is the only correct biblical answer because salvation if of the Lord. The only correct answer is, "I've trusted Christ, who paid for my salvation in full." Even, "I've trusted Jesus as my Savior **and** . . ." is not correct. Why? Because it adds man's works.

It is not our works, but His that saves us. It is not our righteous acts, but His righteousness that gets us into Heaven. God paid for our salvation in the righteous death of His Son, Jesus Christ. The wages of sin is death (separation from God, who is holy). Christ in His death, provided us with the only righteous payment possible. The ible says, "For by grace are you saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: It is the gift of God: not of works, lest any man should boast". Ephesian 2:8, 9.

Salvation is of the Lord because righteousness is of the Lord. Only His righteousness can blot out your sins and give you eternal life with God in Heaven. If you are interested in the details of "how you can obtain His righteousness and get to Heaven", **check** out the next page . . .



God's Righteousness, and How You Can Obtain It (You can't get into heaven without it)

You have no Righteousness in and of yourself:

Romans 3:10, 23 "There is none righteous, no, not one: For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."

You need to know where to get Righteousness:

Romans 5:12, 18 "As by one man [Adam] sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon **all men**, for that all have sinned: As by the offence of one [Adam] judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of One [Christ] the free gift came upon all men [who believe] unto justification of life."

You must believe that you need His Righteousness:

Romans 5: 6, 8 "For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. But God commendeth His **love** toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

You must know Why you need His Righteousness:

<u>Romans 6:23</u> "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

<u>John 3:16a</u> "For God so **love** the world [mankind], that he **gave** His only begotten Son [Jesus Christ].

We must personally accept His Righteousness:

<u>John 3:16b</u> "That **whosoever** believeth in [asks, accepts] Him should not perish [be separated from God forever], but **have** everlasting life [be with God forever].

Just ask Him for His Saving righteousness:

Romans 10:9, 10, 13 "That if thou shalt **confess** with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, **thou shalt be saved.** For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth **confession** is made unto salvation. For whosoever shall **call** upon the name of the Lord **shall be saved.**"



"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotted Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." John 3:16
